Perceptive Experience Content Apps 2.2.0 Release (March 2017)

Perceptive Experience Content Apps in this release provides you with the Content Capture, Documents, Tasks and Workflow App functionality. With these Apps you can view and manage your content with the convenience of a web browser outside of Perceptive Content itself. This document provides an overview of the new functionality available to you.

Available features

This section highlights the features available in the Perceptive Experience Content Apps, version 2.2.0.

- The user interface is updated to provide a Home page where you can view all of the Apps installed on your system.
- You can conduct a quick search for document views.
- View, print, and download documents.
- You can view and open related documents and related tasks.
- View, create, modify, and delete the following annotation types - arrow, check, highlight, line, oval, pen, picture stamp, rectangle, sticky note, text, text stamp, and URL.
- View, modify, and save forms content.
- You now have access to the tasks pane within the DocumentsApp.
- View document tasks assigned to you.
- Create pointer, document deficiency and signature tasks in Perceptive Experience. During creation of a task you can define a start date, due date, instructions, comments and assign users.
- Take action on pointer and document deficiency tasks as well as complete tasks requiring digital signatures.
- Enhanced control of task views through the use of VSL filter parameters within a URL.
- View a visual representation for a digital signatures when applied to documents.
- Capture and review document pages to be saved in Perceptive Content.
- Route documents through a business process with the options of Route Forward, Route Anywhere, Route Back and use parallel routes.

Note: All Perceptive Experience users can print and download documents regardless of any print or export privileges defined in Perceptive Content.

- Resolved an issue where the user cannot create a new annotation because the system was not scaling the drawing view element size correctly. (TFS23890)

Annotations Library 3.1.1 Release (October 2016)

The following features and enhancements are included in this release of the Annotations Library.

This section provides an overview of updates implemented in the Perceptive Experience Annotation Library, version 3.1.1.

- Resolved an issue where the user can select multiple annotations on different pages of a multipage TIFF document and multiple annotations remain highlighted to incorrectly indicate multiple annotations are selected for action. The system was updated so that the annotation most recently selected by the user remains highlighted and active. (TFS 14641)
- Resolved an issue where the system does not display the blue selection box around text annotations when a user edits the text annotation contents on an iPhone. (TFS 14868)
- Resolved an issue where the resize handle is not displayed immediately adjacent to a line or arrow annotation when the viewer zoom level is greater than 100%. The system was updated to more accurately calculate the start and end positions of a line or arrow annotation when displayed in the Experience viewer at zoom levels above 100%. (TFS 14887)
- Resolved an issue where changing the orientation of an iPhone while viewing annotation property dialogs renders some user interface elements outside of the visible area, causes the OK and Cancel buttons to be non-responsive or closes the edit annotation dialog. The system was updated to properly display annotation properties and user interface buttons when the user changes the orientation of a mobile device. (TFS 14920)
- Resolved an issue where the user can resize line and arrow annotations beyond the image limits. It is no longer possible to resize line or arrow annotations beyond image limits. (TFS 15079)
- Resolved an issue where the line weight appearance for line, rectangle, pen, stamp and oval annotations is significantly thinner than the appearance of the same annotations in the Perceptive Content viewer. (TFS 15110).
- Resolved an issue where when a user selects a text or text stamp annotation to edit, but then navigates to another page, the text or text stamp annotations remains selected. Now the system does not retain focus on an annotation after the user navigates to another page. (TFS 15422)
- Resolved an issue where the system unnecessarily requests inactive annotation templates from the server. (TFS 15669)
- Resolved an issue where moving a newly created pen annotation does not result in placement in the accurate location on a document. (TFS 15925)
- Resolved an issue where annotations applied to documents in ImageNow and Perceptive Content with the color set to automatic do not display in Perceptive Experience. A fix was implemented so that annotations applied with the color set to automatic are now displayed with the correct black color applied. (TFS 16256)
- Resolved an issue where a user cannot move a selected arrow annotation in the proper direction on a document with the keyboard arrow keys (TFS 16461).

- Resolved an issue where when the Annotations Container View is set to a read only mode, annotations can be moved, edited and deleted. Now when the Annotations Container View is programmatically set to read only mode annotations cannot be modified. (TFS16603)
- Resolved an issue where the system does not display the visual indicator for placement of an annotation on mobile devices. Now the system correctly displays a blue rectangle to indicate where annotation will be placed once a user has selected an area of a document. (TFS 16753)
- Resolved an issue with moving an annotation during creation. The system now requires that an annotation template and properties are selected and accepted prior to changing the annotation location during the annotation creation process. (TFS 16765)
- Resolved an issue where the user cannot move an existing annotation when using an iPhone when the Edit Properties dialog is open. (TFS 16903)
