What is the MDR Video Touch?

The MDR Video Touch is a hardware device that captures and sends high resolution images and video from a wide range of modalities to PACS/VNA. It provides image and video capture and transfer at the point of care without the need for a workstation.

The MDR Video Touch has a built-in server that handles security, configuration, and the flow of data between the modalities and destination DICOM systems. However, the MDR Video Touch can also connect to an external instance of Pacsgear Core Server to handle these functions.
