Introduction

This IHE integration statement describes the conformance of this PACSgear product with the IHE Technical Framework. The IHE Technical Framework defines a subset of the functional components of the healthcare enterprise called *IHE Actors*, and specifies their interactions in terms of a set of coordinated standards-based transactions. These transactions are organized into functional units called *Integration Profiles* that highlight their capacity to address specific clinical needs.

Users familiar with these concepts can use integration statements as an aid to determine what level of integration this product supports with other systems, and what clinical and operational benefits such integration might provide.
