Enhancements

Perceptive Intelligent Capture 5.6 SP1 now supports Internet Explorer 11 as client browser.

Updates

In the following table, ID # denotes the Software Problem Report identifier Perceptive Software uses internally to track defects, and Case # denotes the Support case number Perceptive Software Customer Support uses to track customer-reported issues.

ID#	Case #	Affected Feature / Engine	Description
TFS11481	N/A	Web Verifier Batch release	Resolved an issue in Web Verifier that could cause a batch to incorrectly release to state 700. This could occur if the user, after verification of the last document in a batch, clicked No in the Would you like to release the batch dialog box, and then returned to the batch list.
TFS11344	N/A	Web Verifier Languages	Resolved an issue where Web Verifier users could not enter Polish-specific characters for the User Name and Password on the login screen.



Installation notes

You must install this hot patch on all servers with Web Verifier installations.

To install this hot patch, complete the following steps.

- 1. Stop or exit **IIS**.
- 2. Extract the files from the hot patch package.
- 3. Back up the contents of the following directories, then replace the DLL and PDB files with the hot patch contents.
 - [installation directory]\Perceptive Intelligent Capture\bin
 - [installation directory]\Perceptive Intelligent Capture Web Server\Bin
- 4. In the [*installation directory*]\Perceptive Intelligent Capture Web Server folder, back up **Login.aspx**. Then, replace **Login.aspx** with the hot patch content.
- 5. To load the new Login.aspx file, clear the browser cache.
- 6. Restart the **IIS** services.

Restore to the previous version

To restore the previous state, complete the following steps.

- 1. Stop or exit **IIS**.
- 2. Restore your back up files to the following directories.
 - [installation directory]\Perceptive Intelligent Capture\bin
 - [installation directory]\Perceptive Intelligent Capture Web Server
 - [installation directory]\Perceptive Intelligent Capture Web Server\Bin
- 3. Restart the **IIS** services.
