New features

This section highlights the new features available in Perceptive Process Mining, version 2.13. These new features include:

New Metric: Event count between activities

It is now possible to define a metric that counts the number of events between the first/last occurrence of an activity from a set of starting activities and the first/last occurrence of an activity from a set of end activities. The count is inclusive of the start and end occurrences.

New Metric: Regular expression

It is now possible to define a metric that uses a list of regular expressions to search and replace text values.

Downloading of unique paths

It is now possible to download a CSV file with information about the unique paths used to create a model.

Minimum change when comparing performance info

When comparing the performance information of a model to that of a baseline model it is now possible to hide the performance information when the absolute value of its change is lower than a specified percentage.

Choice of format for duration values

It is now possible to choose a format for duration values when downloading CSV/XLS data.

Product enhancements

This section highlights the product enhancements available in Perceptive Process Mining, version 2.13. These new enhancements include:

Updated URLs for documentation in some locales

It is now possible to query multiple LDAP groups.

Sorting of users and groups

Users and groups in the administration panel are now sorted alphabetically.

Filtering of users and groups

Added option to filter the lists of users and groups in the administration panel.
