## New features

### Rebranding

Version 2.14 contains mainly rebranding changes following the transfer of the Process Mining product from Lexmark Enterprise Software to Hyland Software, Inc. The rebranding changes include new End-User agreement and renamed folder structure.

## Product enhancements

This section highlights the product enhancements available in Perceptive Process Mining, version 2.14. These new enhancements include:

### Deprecation Notice: Ending support for Adobe Flash

Due to the changes in browser support for Adobe Flash and the announcement by Adobe of ending support for Flash in 2020, Perceptive Process Mining 2.14 will be the last release to provide support for Flash. Starting with version 2.15 or higher Flash functionality may be removed.

### Deprecation Notice: Ending support for Internet Explorer 8

Perceptive Process Mining 2.14 will be the last release to provide support Internet Explorer (IE) 8. Starting with version 2.15 or higher Process Mining will not officially support IE 8.
