New features

This section highlights the new features available in Perceptive Process Mining, version 2.15. These new features include:

Support for Excel version 2007

It is now possible to select Excel 2007 (.xlsx) format when exporting data and results into Excel files.

Overriding the default server time zone

The time zone default for the Process Mining server can now be overridden using a new configuration parameter. For more details on how to do that, refer to the *Perceptive Process Mining Installation Guide*.

Product enhancements

This section highlights the product enhancements available in Perceptive Process Mining, version 2.15. These new enhancements include:

Ending support for Adobe Flash

Due to the changes in browser support for Adobe Flash and the announcement by Adobe of ending support for Flash in 2020, Perceptive Process Mining 2.15 does not provide support for Flash any longer.

Ending support for 32-bit server platform

Starting with version 2.15, only 64-bit platforms will be supported.

Ending support for Internet Explorer 8

Perceptive Process Mining 2.15 does not support officially IE 8 any more.
