Enhancements

The following enhancements are included in this release.

- In eAuthorize the existing Envoy and Perceptive Integration Engine (PIE) based web service components are replaced with a Perceptive Connect Runtime (PCR) based connector. The PIE is replaced with Perceptive Connect Runtime framework. The SubmitForSignature, SendToAssureSign and DownloadSignedDocuments ASQ operations are implemented in the new PCR bundles. - eAuthorize currently supports HTTPS communication.(US106158)
- The AssureSign operations are implemented in the new PCR bundles. (US102600)
- You can configure Connect ASQ for Perceptive Content 7.1.5 or higher. (US104700).
- You can configure AssureSign parameters and Email parameters in the eAuthorize Configuration page of the Perceptive Connect Runtime dashboard.(US105799)

Perceptive eAuthorize Patch (February 11, 2013)

Perceptive eAuthorize is a solution that enables you to send documents for electronic signature to any authorized signatory, including non-ImageNow users.

Enhancements

- The installer now facilitates the automated creation of custom properties, a reason list, reasons, tasks, and audit history forms, and also creates a demonstration workflow. (US 10736)
- You can now sign documents that are in version control. (US 9306)
- There is now a Refresh button in Audit History eForm. (US 11229)
- You can now submit a document for signature through eForm. (US 534)

- You can now store both the original document and the signed document separately, rather than the signed document always replacing the original. (US 16115)
- There is now support for signing on mobile devices to be in line with AssureSign.
