Perceptive eAuthorize (February 11, 2013)

Perceptive eAuthorize is a solution that enables you to send documents for electronic signature to any authorized signatory, including non-ImageNow users.

Enhancements

- The installer now facilitates the automated creation of custom properties, a reason list, reasons, tasks, and audit history forms, and also creates a demonstration workflow.
- You can now sign documents that are in version control.
- There is now a Refresh button in Audit History eForm.
- You can now submit a document for signature through eForm.
- You can now store both the original document and the signed document separately, rather than the signed document always replacing the original.
- There is now support for signing on mobile devices to be in line with AssureSign.
